Barker River Expeditions has the right to make schedule changes to alternate rivers or river sections and river craft changes when necessary for safety. Extreme water conditions may mean that paddle rafts and/or inflatable kayaks cannot be used. When last minute changes are necessary we may not have time to inform you before your trip. On exceedingly rare occasions, if water levels do not allow us to float the entire trip, you may reschedule until our next available river trip or continue with us on an incredible Canyoneering adventure. We conduct these portions of our Owyhee and Bruneau Expeditions by land with vehicle support, traveling to the most dramatic sections of the Owyhee-Bruneau Canyonlands, taking day hikes, and Canyoneering up incredible side streams and visiting natural hot springs.

Liability and Trip Insurance

BARKER RIVER EXPEDITIONS spares nothing to ensure that all trips we operate are the safest and best outfitted expeditions available. Our safety record is excellent. However, river running and hiking are not without some risk, and you, as a participant, must be willing to assume this risk. BARKER RIVER EXPEDITIONS assumes no responsibility for your personal safety or for damage or loss of your equipment. We recommend the purchase of trip insurance from your local travel agent. Should you have to cancel your trip plans, all deposits and final payments are non-refundable. Please understand that we cannot insure your investment in river a trip and travel costs. Once you sign up, due to Federal river plans, we lose the right to sell your reserved space to other individuals or groups. Therefore, we regret that we cannot make exceptions for personal emergencies.
